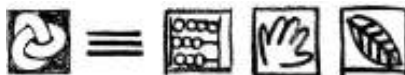

A co-founder of OneWorld and in addition is a founder and director of a Tilapia Fish Farming Venture, Aurelian Aquaculture.

- Financial structuring, strategy development and negotiation with local and international investors investing in the renewable energy industry in South Africa.
- Lead consultant on the financing section of the SA Wind Energy Programme as funded by the UNDP and lead by the DME.
- Consultant on the ICMM / World Bank project as lead by B Hoffman as well as on the Natural Gas Development Project
- Lead the development of a private Game Farm on the border of Madikwe Game Reserve. This has entailed financial structuring, infrastructure development, and negotiations with local farmers, landowners and communities. It also involved negotiations with government, which lead to a contractual agreement between private landowners and North West Parks and Tourism, resulting in the removal of fences on the common boundary and incorporation of private land into the Game Reserve (under conservation control of the Park).

2004 – Current Commercial Director Aurelian Aquaculture

- Instrumental in the start up and development of an intensive, re-circulating, solar heated fish farming system suitable for the growing of fresh water fish requiring warm water. Tilapia has been the main focus. The system is environmentally friendly consuming very little water per day (can be run from a borehole) and wastewater can be used as fertiliser for crop production.

1990 – Current Consultant to Motswari Wildlife Services (t/a Motswari Game Lodge)

- Consult to the owners of the business on their financial and to the business itself on all aspects of the business, including marketing and financial strategies, business development and strategic planning.
